Today, Max Abraham, Manager of the Partners FOR the Saskatchewan River Basin, in conjunction with Ruth Elliot’s grade five class from Caswell Community School, introduced this exciting new program. “Click on Climate is an **action-based program** for children aged eight to 13” Mr. Abraham said. “It helps them understand the causes and impacts of climate change and what they can do about it.”

The goal of the Click on Climate program is to promote and **develop conservation practices and other stewardship behaviours** in children that reduce human impact on climate. The main event of this program is a field trip that takes place within the community.

Each Click on Climate Kit contains the leadership and educational materials as well as field trip supplies needed for 5 children. The program is very versatile and leaders can choose from a variety of activities or can use the standard field day.

We will be conducting in-services in Saskatoon and Regina over the next two days to train leaders from watershed/stewardship/community groups on how to get the most out of Click on Climate. This information will also be made available online at www.saskriverbasin.ca.
