

The Fred Heal Conservation Award

Description and Procedures

Partners FOR the Saskatchewan River Basin is accepting nominations for the Fred Heal Conservation Award. The award was established in 1998 in memory of Fred Heal, the driving force behind the creation of the Partners FOR the Saskatchewan River Basin.

“The Fred Heal Conservation Award will recognize a for-profit or a community organization that has taken direct initiative in preserving and/or enhancing the health of the Saskatchewan River Basin. The organization will by October 1st of the year of the award:

- **Have developed and implemented a program or policy that results in direct benefit to the health of the basin;**
- **Show measurable results from the initiative;**
- **Show continued dedication toward environmental sustainability.”**

1. The award will be presented at the annual AGM in the fall of each year.
2. The call for applications will be in the summer newsletter, by June 30th.
3. Applications will be accepted until October 1st of each year.
4. The decision committee is to be appointed by the board.

Nominators should submit an application form (on website) outlining the following:

1. Name and address of the organization
2. Main contact name(s) and numbers
3. Description of program or policy (not to exceed one page)
4. What they have achieved to date under the program or policy
5. Evidence of long-term commitment to the Saskatchewan River Basin.

Organizations are encouraged to submit nominations on their own behalf.
